Stack the animals on top of each other to form a pyramid. Then have your child roll the ball to knock them down. Whatever animal they knock down they have to



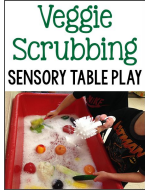
make that noise.

2. Duck Duck Goose. This classic game is perfect for a farm-themed party. Set the kids in a circle, have one start by placing her hand on top of each player, saying "Duck, duck, duck," and when she's ready, say "Goose!" The person whose head she touched will get up and chase her. If she makes it back to the empty spot, she's safe. If not, she's in the mush pot.
